

2013 Statewide Union Officer Elections Calendar

- Feb. 2 - Delegate Assembly selects Elections Committee: Minati Roychoudhuri (Chair, CCC), Cindy Casper (NCC), Ray Esponda (GWCC), Bob Fernandez (QVCC), Seth Freeman (CCC), Sue Montez (NCC), Fred Odell (MCC), Bill Searle (ACC), Trent Wright (MXCC)
- Feb. 4 - "Call for Candidates" e-mail sent to members
- Bio Forms available on web site
- March 1 - 4 PM deadline for nominations to be received by Elections Committee @ 4C's office. Nominations may also be made from the floor of the March 2 Delegate Assembly, 10 AM, 4C's Office.
- March 2 - Delegate Assembly nominates candidates
- March 18 - Candidate Bio forms and Photos due
- Chapter nominations due (if participating, see below)
- March 18-26 - Election materials prepared and uploaded
- March 28 - Election Notice postcard mailed to all members' home address (includes URL for voting and how to view candidate information, plus voting credentials). Timed to arrive in homes when election website is open for voting.
- April 1 - Deadline for becoming a Member who is eligible to vote (Kit in the 4C's office should receive membership card on or before this date.)
- Election Website Open for Voting (email sent to all members' official college email announcing the start of the election)
- April 8 - Reminder email sent to all 4C's members using 4C's database (mostly the same list as above, but may include some home emails)
- April 18 - Election Closes at midnight
- April 19 - Election Committee decides upon any challenge ballots and certifies results
- May 3 - Candidates take office

Note: **Chapters may choose** to elect their local officers and delegates in conjunction with the 4C's statewide elections. Ballots will be prepared by the Congress and voting will occur using the same voting procedures. Chapters must nominate candidates and get their names to Mary Van Buren (mary@the4cs.org) by March 18, 2013. If the chapter would like to include candidate photos and bios, this must be submitted by March 18 as well.
